- 2. To grant occupation of the Units to applicants in the following priority order of category:-
- 2.1 Residents of the parish of Mulbarton who have lived in the parish for a total of at least 3 of the last 10 years
- 2.2 former Residents of the parish of Mulbarton who lived in the parish for at least 3 of the last 10 years
- 2.3 Residents of the parish of Mulbarton who have lived in the parish of Mulbarton or the adjacent parishes of Bracon Ash, East Carleton, Swardeston and Swainsthorpe for the last 3 years or more
- 2.4 people working in the parish of Mulbarton and have done so for the last year or more for at least 10 hours each week

- 2.5 Residents of the adjacent parishes of Bracon Ash, East Carleton, Swardeston and Swainsthorpe, who have lived in one or more of these parishes (or the parish of Mulbarton) for the last 3 years or more
- 2.6 Residents of the parish of Mulbarton who have lived in the parish for less than 3 years
- 2.7 Residents of the adjacent parishes of Bracon Ash, East Carleton, Swardeston and Swainsthorpe, who have lived in these parishes (or the parish of Mulbarton) for less than 3 years
- 2.8 residents of South Norfolk
